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More notable new restaurants:

Fame Supper Club

Fancy a \$160 steak? A tomahawk rib steak is available on the menu at Fame Supper Club, opened Aug. 27 in River North. Veteran chef and partner Mark Sparacino also owns Prosecco restaurant nearby. Pastry chef Rychelle Jean-Simon makes a piña colada baked Alaska (\$11) with coconut and pineapple gelato drizzled with caramel, flambéed tableside.

The cocktail menu features a cosmopolitan mocktail (\$9) with Seedlip Grove 42 Citrus, a nonalcoholic spirit, mixed with the classic cranberry juice, lime and simple syrup. The new glam lounge and restaurant promises live musicians and DJs each night, but they're only open with indoor service Fridays and Saturdays for now.
